Mining Company Invested 66 million colones on Country Roads

- Industrias Infinito: Committed with Human Development.

Due to an agreement signed by Industrias Infinito S.A. (IISA), the Cooperative of Electrification Coopelesca and San Carlos Municipality, a total of 27kms of roads were repaired among the Crucitas Project nearby communities.

The agreement that benefited Infiernillo, Moravia, Chamorro, Crucitas and El Roble communities, was made possible thanks to the donation made by the mining firm of at least 21.600 square meters of ballast that are worth 64 million colones (face's price). In addition, 1.5 million colones were donated in drains and around 500 thousand colones were invested in overtime payments.

“It is very rewarding for the company to have concluded the road works planned on the agreement before winter time. It is important to emphasize the municipal mayor's will and development vision, which predicts a better coordination with the municipality for the development of future social welfare projects”, IISA's General Manager, Jesús Carvajal indicated. He was also grateful for the inhabitants contribution and for “ignoring the bad faith of one of the few opponents to the mining project that seemed not to want neither a mine nor development for the communities”, Carvajal specified.

The improvement of these roads will guarantee the communities inhabitants a peaceful winter and it will guarantee Coopelesca an extension on the electrical service among more families of these marginalized communities.
